

Reptile Adoption Agreement

Please fill out all details and sign / print details as appropriate. This is a mutual agreement made between the new owner / South West Reptile Rescue and Rehab when any reptile is adopted out into their forever home.

- During our care all reptiles will receive a health check at the Vets, a full Faecal check, treated and rehabilitated if needed and will be monitored for a minimum of 4 weeks before rehoming.
- All reptiles will be in full health and tame unless otherwise stated (naturally aggressive species / long term health issues that can be managed)
- Copy's of our own health checks / history and care plans can be provided upon request.
- Reptiles will be rehomed only when all checks have been carried out and proof of suitable set up is provided and we withhold the right to revoke adoption at any time before the reptile is handed over.
- A non refundable deposit is required to reserve any reptile - this will be taken off the adoption fee or will only be returned in the event we revoke adoption.
- We are available for on going advice at any time.
- In the unlikely event that your reptile falls ill / gets injured and you are unable to provide veterinary care we request that you contact us for support.
- In the unlikely event that you need to rehome your reptile it is required that they are handed back to the the rescue or to be rehomed through us.
